

Conakry Port



**Specific Requirements applied to the Conakry Port for the reception of ships related to Ebola Alert:**

Considering the reality of the epidemic of Ebola virus infection in parts of Guinea and the invaluable efforts of the Government and partners to contain it.

Also concerned with the preservation ship and the crew members calling at our port, the harbour Master, working in concert with the Port Authority health, has decided to put in place a safety and security device accordance with to the recommendations of the crisis committee for the struggle against Ebola.

The present security arrangements have been made as follows:

- 1- A team from the National struggle Committee against the Ebola virus is put in place in Port;
- 2- Laser thermometer to determine the temperature stevedores, the ship's pilot and the team in charge of the usual formalities on board ship;
- 3- A contingency plan has been put in place to Conakry port for the Ebola alert.
- 4- Reducing the number of persons in charge of usual formalities on board ships;
- 5- The team responsible for the usual formalities (customs, immigration, police, harbour master's office, health, maritime agencies, shipping) must minimize lengthy stays on board of ships;
- 6- Health and Cleaning services shall be based on the quay (e.g. dockworkers in charge of handling of goods);
- 7- The public services are required to follow their working procedures in avoiding physical contact with the ship's crew;
- 8- Mandatory use of bleach for disinfecting hands before boarding the ship for any job;
- 9- Compulsory wearing rain flap and gloves,
- 10- The ship's pilot must have to wear rain flap, gloves and to disinfect hands before boarding the ship
- 11- Ship crew members are not allowed to leave the ship, exception made for the surveyor who will be required to follow all Conakry Port health and safety/security rules every time the disembarks;
- 12- Issuing of a certificate by the health Authority to the ship on leaving for the next Port of call.

We hope that these specific requirements respond to your concerns.
